

Free Bus Service For Visitation Is Available To DJJ Families



Assisting Families With Inmates

A visit from a family member is one of the most supportive and meaningful things you can do for your son or daughter while he/she is away. We at the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice understand how frustrating it is to want to visit your child at a juvenile correctional center, but you don't have a vehicle available or it's just too far to drive.

That is no longer a barrier, thanks to a partnership DJJ has forged with James River Transportation and Assisting Families With Inmates. JRT will provide a clean, modern shuttle bus operated by a courteous driver that will take your family in relaxing comfort to DJJ's Bon Air Juvenile Correctional Center during regular visitation hours. Shuttle service is currently provided on the third Sunday of every month from the Tidewater-Virginia Beach area.

There is no cost to you. All you have to do is arrive at the appointed time at one of the locations noted in the box at left, get on board, sit back and enjoy the ride. We'll take care of the rest.

Each juvenile can receive no more than two visitors at a time. Since there are limited seats on each vehicle, we ask that you call your child's probation officer at least five days in advance of your visit to reserve a seat. Children must be at least 1 year old and walking; families must provide car seat.
