


SOCIAL DISTANCING FOR BON AIR STAFF



Social Distancing are actions that the Bon Air Juvenile Correctional Center community can take to minimize close contact with residents and each other in order to reduce the spread of COVID-19.




**NO HANDSHAKES

DJJ STAFF AT WORK

Work in ways that minimize close contact with your co-workers and residents. Remember, six feet is considered the minimum safe distance.

Minimize groups over 10 people.

Clean your work area frequently.

DJJ STAFF OUTSIDE OF WORK

Stay at home and do not go out in public when you are sick.

Avoid medical settings unless necessary.

Maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from others.

Wave instead of shaking hands.

Practice excellent personal hygiene habits including frequent handwashing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
