Free Bus Service For Visitation Is Available To DJJ Families

A visit from a family member is one of the most supportive and meaningful things you can do for your son or daughter while he/she is away. We at the Department of Juvenile Justice understand how frustrating it is to want to visit your child but have no vehicle available, or it's just too far to drive.

That is no longer a barrier, thanks to a partnership DJJ has forged with James River Transportation and VanGo Transportation services through Assisting Families of Inmates. Every month on a Sunday from numerous Court Service Unit locations throughout the Commonwealth, they will provide a clean, modern shuttle bus operated by a courteous driver that will take your family in relaxing comfort to visit your child during regular visitation hours.

- There is no cost to you.
- To reserve a seat, contact your child's parole officer at least five days before you want to visit.
- Arrive at your designated Court Service Unit on time.
- Families must provide a car seat for small children.
- Get on board, sit back and enjoy the ride.

Your child's parole officer will tell you which locations are served and on which Sunday. Since there are limited seats on each vehicle, we ask that you call at least five (5) business days in advance of your visit to reserve your seat.
